Location Map





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| <p> 1 Industrial Pkwy., Paving
Pave Industrial Pkwy. from Dunham St. to Suntra Way. Funding provided by the Ohio Public Works Commission (OPWC) funds which requires a 50% local match.
Estimate: \$900,000
Schedule: Summer/Early Fall</p> | <p> 2 Millwood Blvd. Extension
Extend Millwood Blvd eastward from SR-31 to SR-4. Funding provided by the establishment of a Tax Increment Financing (TIF) district.
Estimate: \$2.8 Million
Schedule: Spring-Fall</p> | <p> 3 2016 CDBG Program
Replace sidewalks along sections of E 5th St., Oak St., E 4th St. and Vine St. Funding provided by the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG).
Estimate: \$75,000
Schedule: Summer/Early Fall</p> | <p> 4 Main St., Sanitary Sewer
Relocate a section of sanitary sewer which will be in conflict with future ODOT bridge construction on Main St. Funding provided by ODOT.
Estimate: \$100,000

| <p> 5 US-33 EB Ramp, Widening
Widen the exit ramp for US-33 EB at Northwest Pkwy to add a left turn lane to accommodate additional traffic generated by the proposed Kroger on W. 5th St. Funding provided by contributions from Kroger.
Estimate: \$200,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 6 W 4th St., Paving & Curb
Replace the curb along the north side of W 4th St. Mill and overlay the portion of the existing asphalt surface not included in the water repair work from 2015.
Estimate: \$350,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 7 S. Walnut St., Culvert
Replace the existing culvert on S. Walnut St. A sidewalk will be added for future sidewalk connectivity on S. Walnut St. Funding provided by the City's Stormwater Utility Fund.

Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 8 W 5th St., Sidewalks
Replace sections of sidewalk along W 5th St. from Grove St. to Maple St. Funding is provided by the ODOT Safe Routes To Schools program.

| <p> 9 Pavement Maintenance
This annual project includes asphalt resurfacing for City-maintained streets. All streets are evaluated annually and assigned a rating based on condition. Streets are then prioritized and included in the program as funding allows.
Estimate: \$1,000,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 10 W 5th St., Storm Sewer
Replace storm sewer along the north side W 5th St from Grove St to Park Ave. Funding provided by the City's Stormwater Utility Fund.
Estimate: \$230,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 11 1st St., Waterline
Replace the existing 4 inch Cast Iron waterline on 1st St with an 8 inch Ductile Iron line. Funding provided by the City's Water Improvement Fund.
Estimate: \$100,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 12 Reservoir, Boat Ramp
Reconfigure the parking, access and boat ramp to accommodate public access to boating and fishing at the reservoir. Funding provided by a grant from ODNR.
Estimate: \$427,250

| <p> 13 Scottslawn Rd., Bridge
ODOT funded and managed project that will replace the bridge on Scottslawn Rd. at the US-33 interchange.
Estimate: \$2,791,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall</p> | <p> 14 SR-4/US-36, Paving
ODOT funded and managed project which resurfaces SR-4/US-36 from the southwest limit at the Union County line to Collins Ave. Turn lanes will be constructed for NB/SB left turning traffic at Collins Ave.

Schedule: Spring/Summer</p> | <p> 15 W 5th St., Roadway
Developer funded and managed project that will widen W 5th St. to provide the turn lanes needed for the new Kroger development. Includes a traffic signal, curb, sidewalks and drainage work.
