

# City Refuse, Recycling and Bulk Collection

## Fact Sheet

### What can be recycled?

#### Acceptable Items

- Paper products
- Flattened cardboard, smaller than 2 feet by 2 feet
- Metal and Glass food and beverage containers, Rinsed
- #1 & #2 Plastics, Rinsed

#### Unacceptable Items

- #3 - #7 Plastics
- Styrofoam
- Automotive parts
- Plastic bags
- Pesticide/chemical containers
- Toys
- Batteries
- Paint/aerosol cans
- Appliances
- Electronics

### Observed Holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving
- Christmas

### Bulk Item Pickup

Bulk items are collected every Monday\* and require scheduling by 4:30 pm on the preceding Friday. To schedule a bulk pickup submit the request via email at [publicservice@marysvilleohio.org](mailto:publicservice@marysvilleohio.org) or call (937)645-7350, option #2. Please specify what items are to be collected and include a contact name, phone number and E-mail with the request. Bulk collection is limited to piles no larger than 10 feet long, 4 feet wide and 4 feet high.

\* On holidays bulk will be collected on Tuesday.

#### Acceptable Items

- Mattresses and box springs must be securely wrapped in plastic.
- Five or more loose items such as lumber, posts, etc. are to be bundled and not exceed 4 feet in length, 2 feet in diameter and weigh less than 40 pounds. All nails must be removed.
- Rugs, carpets and pads must be rolled and tied at both ends and no longer than 6 feet.
- Couches, furniture, TV's, etc.
- Appliances (refrigerant must be removed from refrigerators, freezers, AC units, dehumidifiers, etc.)
- Grills and push mowers (without engine)

#### Unacceptable Items

- Hazardous waste (oil, paint, chemicals)
- Building or construction material from commercial work
- Major automobile components or tires

### Refuse and Recycling Collection

Refuse and recycling are collected weekly, Tuesday through Friday according to the location of the residence. See the City's Refuse Route Map for more information.

- Do not overfill, wedge items inside or place bags on top of containers. The container lid must securely close and container should completely empty.
- All refuse items are to be placed in the green container and recycling items are to be placed in the blue container.
- Do not exceed weight limit listed on container.
- Container must be out by 6:00 am on the collection day and be removed within 24 hours of collection.
- Place containers with lid opening facing the street (handle toward the house).
- Set containers in the street, 3 feet apart, wheels within 1 foot of curb or edge of the street.
- Have at least 3 feet between the containers and surroundings. Do not place containers under trees or wires.
- No tires or hazardous materials such as paint batteries, oil or chemicals will be accepted in refuse container.
- Live holiday trees will be collected with yard waste.
- Collection will be delayed one day on holiday weeks. Friday collection will occur on Saturday.
