Stormwater Fund

The City's Stormwater Fund receives revenue from a fee included on each utility customer's bill. Residents are charged for 1 Equivalent Residential Unit (ERU) and Businesses pay based on the size of imperious area.

The stormwater improvements along West 5th Street (between Grove Street and Park Avenue) include removal and replacement of existing storm lines along the westbound lane of West 5th Street. Two-way traffic will be maintained on West 5th Street for the duration of the project.


The existing storm sewer warrants replacement due to permanent settling of the pavement due to old, deteriorating storm pipe. The new storm sewer will provide increased capacity for stormwater drainage as well as a better pavement surface on West 5th Street. New concrete curb and sidewalk will also be installed along the length of the stormwater improvements project.

In addition to the work on W 5th Street, curb, underdrains and curb inlets will be installed on the west side of Grand Ave. between W 5th Street and W 3rd Street.

Funding Information

J&J Schlaegel Inc. was awarded the contract for this project. Their bid of \$253,868 will be funded by a combination of Stormwater and Streets Funding.
