## INFORMATION AT A GLANCE

Estimated project cost to remove and replace the entire bridge deck.

The State Route 31 Bridge Improvements project is 100% funded and managed by the Ohio Department of Transportation.



ODOT plans to spend \$12.3 Million on improvements within Union County that will directly impact Marysville residents (see below).

### Traffic Impact

Traffic will be restricted to one lane in each direction through the work zone during construction. Temporary traffic signals will be used to assist traffic flow and minimize delays.

### Location

The bridge is located on State Route 31 over US 33 on the north side of Marysville and serves as a main access route to and from the city. It also connects to the Mill Valley subdivision which is Marysville's largest subdivision.
