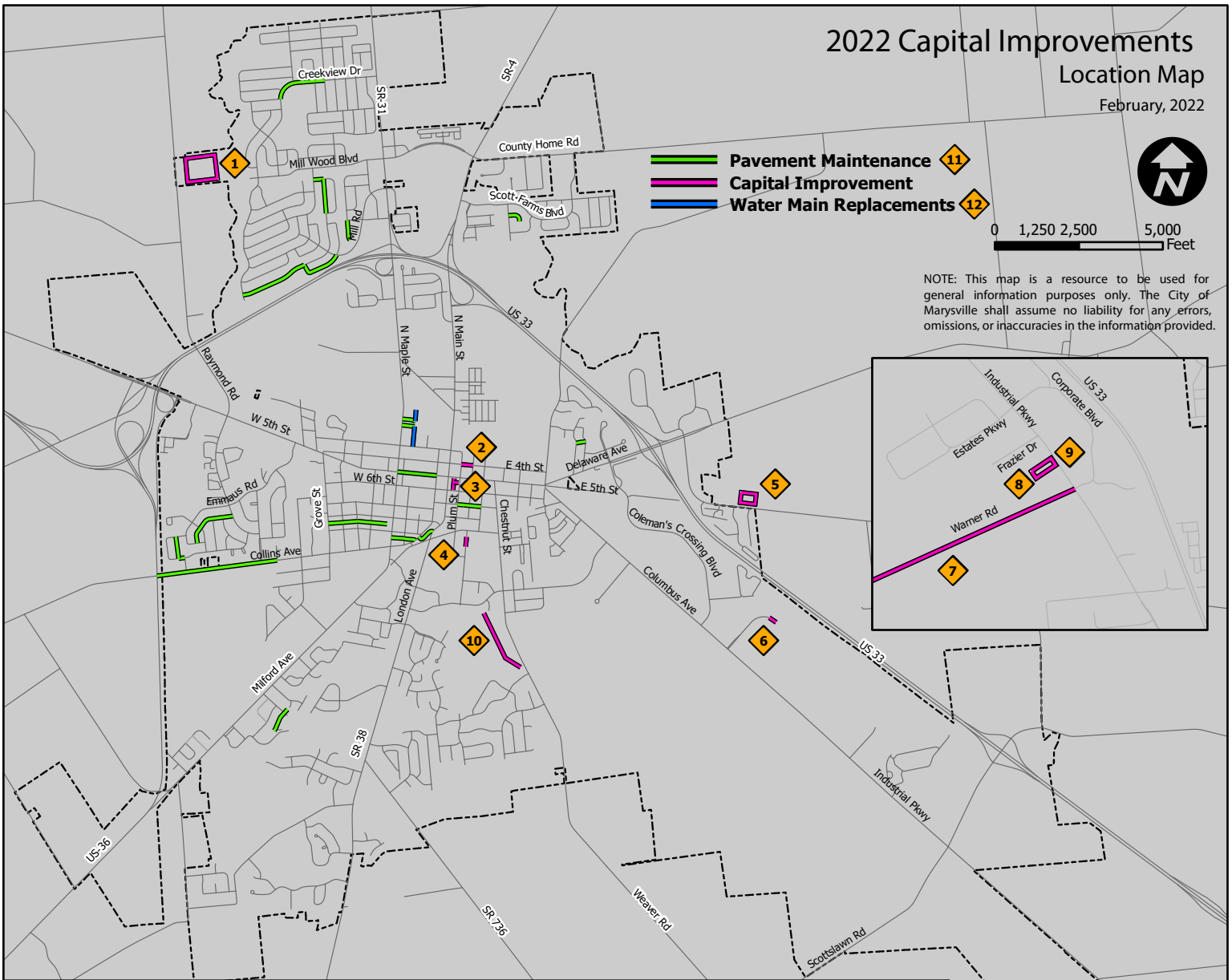
Location Map

1 Water Treatment Plant

The construction of a new water treatment plant, replacing the City's existing plant located at 409 N Main St. The existing plant is rated for 4 million gallons per day (MGD) and has been in operation since 1891. The new plant will have a capacity of 7.5 MGD, serving the needs of our community for many years.
Estimate: \$50,000,000
Schedule: 2022 - 2023

2 E 4th St Bridge Replacement

Replace the existing bridge and culvert serving Town Run between Plum St. and Walnut St.
Estimate: \$800,000
Schedule: Spring - Late Fall

3 Uptown Alley Improvements

Reconstruction of the alleys between 5th, 6th, Main, and Plum Streets to provide a public seating area including brick paving, lighting, landscaping, and improved pedestrian accessibility.
Estimate: \$700,000
Schedule: Spring

4 S Walnut St Culvert Replacement

Replacement of the existing culvert on S Walnut St over Town Run. The culvert will be sized to accommodate future road widening.
Estimate: \$320,000
Schedule: Fall-Winter

5 Watkins Rd Pump Station

Replacement of a deteriorating pump station serving the East side of Marysville. The new pump station will be sized to accommodate future growth in the area.
Estimate: \$6,500,000
Schedule: 2022 - 2023

6 Innovation Way Extension

400 ft roadway extension to serve the newly developed Southgate property. Includes pedestrian path and lighting.
Estimate: \$425,000
Schedule: Spring - Fall

7 Warner Rd Utility Extension

Over 5,500 LF of water line and 7,300 of sanitary sewer will be installed along Warner Rd to provide service to Amazon and future developments in Southern Union County.
Estimate: \$7,500,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall

8 Pump Station #2

Replace the City's existing Pump Station #2 which has been identified as undersized and a limiting factor in the City's ability to provide wastewater service to Jerome Township and the Southeastern portion of the City's service area.
Estimate: \$7,500,000
Schedule: 2022 - 2023

9 Jerome Twp Water Tower

This new water tower will provide improved pressure as well as critical redundancy to the Southern Union County service area. The tower capacity will be approx 1.5 million gallons.
Estimate: \$5,000,000
Schedule: 2022 - 2023

10 Bishop Ditch

Replace the existing drain conduit along Bishop Run. The new conduit, basins, and ditch will reestablish drainage routes and mitigate flooding concerns in the area.
Estimate: \$800,000
Schedule: Spring - Fall

11 Pavement Maintenance

This annual project includes asphalt resurfacing for City maintained streets. Streets are evaluated annually and assigned a rating based on condition. Streets are then prioritized and included in the program as funding allows.
Estimate: \$1,500,000
Schedule: Summer/Fall

12 Sycamore St, Waterline

Replace the existing 6 inch Cast Iron waterline on Sycamore St with an 8 inch PVC line.
Estimate: \$100,000
Schedule: Spring
